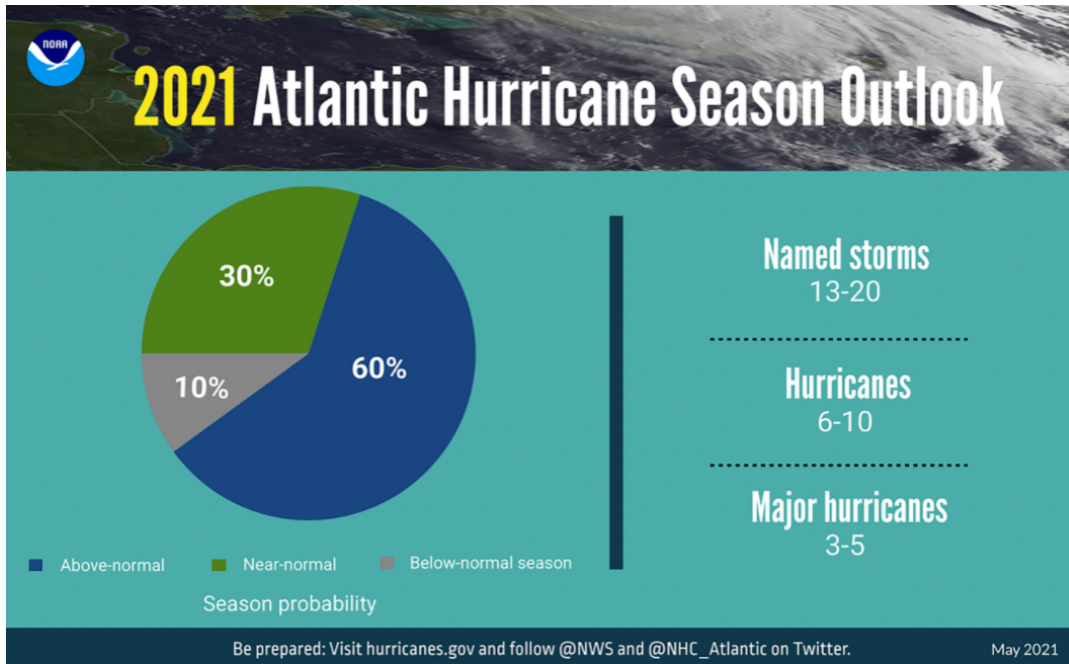




2021 HURRICANE SEASON
